Code of Good Conduct for: Badminton

GENERAL

All members of the Leeds University Badminton Club (LUBC) must adhere to the following rules and guidelines which constitute our Code of Conduct. All of our members:


- ⤴ must respect others and in no circumstance offend or discriminate on the grounds of their race, religion, disability or sexual orientation.
- ⤴ will behave appropriately when representing both the club and the University in training sessions and matches.
- ⤴ should respect the sports halls and facilities provided for us to use by using appropriate footwear and ensuring the halls are left tidy at the end of sessions.
- ⤴ will be polite and courteous to other club members, sports hall users and staff at the facilities at all times.

MEMBERSHIP

- ⤴ Players are required to pay a membership fee for the year, which enables them to play in the Club and represent the University in teams.
- ⤴ Those who have not paid this fee by the due dates specified by the elected Club Committee will not be eligible to play for the University.
- ⤴ Match fees must be paid on the day of the match, and repeat non-payment will result in dismissal from the team.
- ⤴ Any player who fails to pay the requested Membership Fee shall be refused access to the club.


