Code of Good Practice for: Badminton

INTRODUCTION

Leeds University Badminton Club will operate in accordance with the following document, it's risk assessment, it's code of good conduct and current LUU Sports Office guidelines.

The club is associated with the following:

- ^ BUCS
- ^ Leeds & District Badminton League

The President, Treasurer and Team Captains are responsible for ensuring all membership fees are paid before agreed deadlines (i.e before first competitive fixtures)

The club will appoint a new committee by the end of Term 3.

CLUB ACTIVITIES

Health and Safety documentation must be available to all club members, however all participants should be aware that they are responsible as individuals for their own actions.

In order to maintain a safe sporting environment, members will:

- ^ Ensure courts are suitable to play on–i.e clean and free from water spills etc.
- ^ Ensure courts are free from foreign objects
- ^ Wear appropriate footwear and clothing
- ^ Warm up and warm down
- ^ Keep a safe distance from courts when not participating
- ^ Not play when injured or ill
- ^ Where appropriate sessions will be lead by a qualified coach
- ^ Consult committee members or experienced players if unsure about anything

FIRST AID

Leeds University Badminton will follow the LUU Sports Office guidelines and Sport and Physical Activity guidelines for First Aid provision

ACCIDENT AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Leeds University Badminton will follow the LUU Sports Office Sport and Physical Activity Accident and Emergency procedures.

CLUB'S COMPLAINT PROCEDURE

The club will operate a procedure that allows club members to raise complaints about issues which may include the following:

- ⤴ The safety of club activities
- ⤴ The standards of instruction and leadership
- ⤴ The standard of equipment used by the Club
- ⤴ Poor club administration
- ⤴ Lack of resources
- ⤴ Lack of involvement in the club, depending on ability

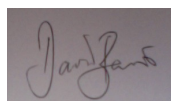
Any issues raised by Club members should be initially addressed by the Club President and/or the appropriate Team Captain, the issue will then be discussed at the following committee meeting.

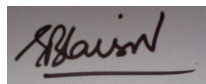
