Code of Good Practice for: Men's Cricket

1.0 Aim of Document

This document outlines the procedures within and expected behaviour of all members of Leeds University Union Men's Cricket Club, and therefore acts as an agreement between the paid members and Leeds University Union Men's Cricket Club. As a result of signing this document, it will be expected that each member will endeavour to follow the guidelines as practically as possible, and consequently accept any reparations in the event of breaking the code.

The name of the club is Leeds University Union Men's Cricket Club, hereafter to be referred to as "the club".

2.0 Membership

2.1 To be eligible to participate within any club activity, members must have, at the very least, paid the first tear of membership and completed the online registration via Leeds University Union website.

2.2 For the Academic year 2011/12, there are two tears of membership, these are;

- Club Membership
- Squad Membership

2.2.1 Club membership entitles the member to participate in all social activities related to the club and to attend club practice sessions. For the academic year 2011/12, the fee is set at £20

2.2.2 Squad membership needs to be paid by all existing squad members from the previous academic year if their wish is to continue playing within the squad. Additionally, after selection for the squad by trials or by other means a full squad membership will need to be paid before being able to participate in games and squad training.

In the event of a player having already paid club membership, an additional fee will need to pay to upgrade to squad membership.

The fee for club membership for the academic year 2011/12 is £50. Therefore, the upgrade cost from club to squad membership is £30.

- 2.3 Once membership has been paid, under no circumstances will it be refunded.
- 2.4 All members must sign to say that they have read and understand the club's code of conduct and the responsibilities that are specifically related to them.
- 2.5 After becoming a member, it is the responsibility of individuals to bring attention to any known medical conditions, disabilities, or previous injuries that may affect their or other club member's safe participation within the sport.

3.0 Committee

- 3.1 The club shall hold 7 official committee positions for the academic year 2011/12. This may be subject to change by a majority vote at the next AGM. The current committee will remain responsible until it has officially been signed over to the incoming committee.
- 3.2 The executive Committee is made up of;
 - The Club Captain
 - Treasurer
 - Secretary

The executive committee will hold responsibility for the whole club. The club captain has the most senior role within the Executive Committee, and thus has overall leadership.

- 3.3 Additional roles within the committee for 2011/12
 - Sponsorship Sec
 - Fixture Sec
 - Kit Sec
 - Social Sec

- 3.4 It is the responsibility of each committee member to understand their roll within the club, and if have questions or are unable to complete a task, must inform a member of the exec committee.
- 3.5 The Committee will be convened by the Secretary and shall meet agreed intervals and not less than four times per year.
- 3.5 An elected Committee member ceases to be such if he or she ceases to be a member of the club, resigns by written notice, or is removed by the Committee for good cause after the member concerned has been given the chance of putting their case to the Committee.

4.0 Training

- 4.1 Attendance at squad training sessions (if selected) is compulsory.
- 4.2 All Players should arrive prepared with the appropriate equipment, at least 15 minutes before each session and are expected to be in attendance for the duration of the session.
- 4.3 Any squad member not attending a session should give adequate notice, with an explanation to one of the exec committee so the necessary action can be taken to inform a non-squad member of the opportunity to train with the squad.
- 4.4 Consistent absence from squad trainings will jeopardise a players place in the squad and thus the limit the potential to play for the university in the summer.

5.0 Matches

- 5.1 Players should abide the Code of Good conduct to maintain the respect and integrity of the club and university. Failure to do so will result in a disciplinary hearing with the maximum penalty being band from BUCS matches.

6.0 Social Activities

- 6.1 Social activities must be coherent of the LUUMCC social guidelines.
- 6.2 The Social Secretary must be aware of all clauses within the social guidelines.
- 6.3 Failure to adhere to the social guidelines of any LUUMCC member on a social will sit before the stated disciplinary committee.

Leeds University Union Men's Cricket club hereby adopts and accepts this Constitution as a current operating guide regulating the actions of all members.
