Code of Good Conduct for: Tenpin Bowling

Introduction:

This document is an agreement between the club and the members associated. It will display the commitment of the committee and their goals to be completed during the academic year. It will be a point of reference for any disciplinary matters for the attention of the club committee.

Tournaments:

When playing in a competition with the LUU Tenpin Bowling club, the member will be representing both Leeds University and the Leeds tenpin bowling club by wearing issued kit.

Behaviour of each member should be at a good standard that is accepted by the university, this will be explained by a committee member.

It must be understood that behaviours including dishonesty, indecency, harassment, bullying, violence or abuse of drugs are not accepted.

Players will be reported to the university and membership will be removed without a refund in any of these cases.

Social activities:

- **Tours**

After match play all labelled kit must be removed before the event of any social activity.

- **General socials**

Initiations are not permitted at any level.

After match play, in the event of a social all labelled kit must be removed in the presence of alcohol.

Members of activities will not organise socials where checklists of alcoholic drinks are required to be consumed at various pubs.

Especially where these lists contain enough alcohol drinks to take individuals over the government's recommended guidelines for alcohol consumption.

Committee members should be seen as ambassadors and a point of contact for all members.

Committee Meetings

It is the responsibility of all committee members to attend organised meetings, these will occur on the 1st Wednesday of every month. A location will be decided a week in hand.

Minutes of the meeting will be recorded and filed by the secretary.

The Sponsor

The LUU Tenpin Bowling club will try to ensure that they adhere to the terms and conditions that are laid out by the sponsor.

Code of conduct and code of good practise are in place to ensure all players are seen to be representing the university and the sponsor involved with the club.


