Code of Good Practise for: Contemporary Dance Society

We meet on Wednesday evenings 5-6pm for workshops. The location of these will be dependent on the technique being taught. All workshops will be advised to society members via email and places are on a first come first serve basis.

For all workshops, it is advised that all participants wear suitable, loose clothing with trousers not being longer than ankle length. When in the PCI dance studio, all shoes must be removed, however in other spaces trainers or dance shoes are to be worn unless advised otherwise. Details of space specific requirements will be emailed to the participant upon confirmation of their place on the workshop.

We will endeavour to hold warm ups and cool downs in every class. Participants should be aware that dance is a naturally strenuous activity and each individual should participate according to their own health and ability. All members should be aware of the university health and safety policy, notices will be pointed out at the beginning of each session. We reserve the right to refuse admission to workshops if we / the tutor deem somebody to be dressed inappropriately. We will also eject any member should they act in an unsafe manner.

The contemporary dance society always puts the safety of its members at the top of its agenda whilst providing a good learning environment and enjoyment.

Members will be informed of socials and of performances in the local area that they may be interested in. We adhere and follow LUU's social guidelines.
