Code of Good Practise for: Darts Society

- 4.1 No Player or Member shall act in a manner which may reasonably be considered to be prejudicial to the interests or standing of the society or which could reasonably be considered to injure or discredit the society or bring the game of darts into disrepute.
- 4.2 All Players and Members will steadfastly adhere to the society Rules. Any breaches will invite disciplinary action in accordance with the society Rules.
- 4.3 Any Player, Member or Guest who is asked by a Tournament Director to leave a venue at which a Darts Event is taking place under the Tournament Rules, or carry out any other instruction relating to the Darts Event, must do so immediately.
- 4.4 No Player, Member or Official will bet or make any form of wager in connection with any society Event in which he or she is directly involved as a Player, Member or Official. Any Player, Member or Official involved in placing bets on darts matches in relation to his or her own performance, or is involved directly or indirectly in betting in any way that may be reasonably considered dishonest, may be subject to a ban from all Matches and activities of the society.
- 4.5 Players may not, before or during a Darts Event, make an agreement to produce a particular score or to share prize money between those players irrespective of the result.
- 4.6 No Player or Member will abuse, ignore or refuse reasonable requests from an official.
- 4.7 All Players, Members and Guests will desist from any behaviour which may reasonably be construed as gamesmanship before, during or after any Match at any Darts Event.
- 4.8 Every invited Guest is the responsibility of the respective Member or Player who may be held accountable for the Guest's behaviour regardless of whether the Member or Player is with the Guest at the time of any inappropriate behaviour by the Guest.

Code of Good Conduct for: Darts

- 1.1 When competing you are not only representing the society, but the university so you must act as ambassadors. Be gracious in victory and defeat, always shaking hands with your opponent before and after a game and thank them for the contest.
- 1.2 When standing at the oche, you must not use any bad language towards officials, opponents or in frustration at your own performance.
- 1.3 When your opponent is standing at the oche, do not under any circumstances try and put them off, this is gamesmanship and is not the image that should be portrayed by the society.
- 1.4 In the event of your opponent's darts being broken, if you have the relevant parts to fix their darts and enable them to continue the contest do offer, because it is the contest that counts not the result.
- 1.5 Under any circumstances if the scorer for your match makes a mistake, that could benefit or harm your chances in the match and you are aware of this you must highlight it in the interest of fair play.
