## Code of Good Practice for: Duke of Edinburgh Society

---

Members are expected to:

- Regularly attend meetings.
- Attend training sessions.
- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for expeditions and training sessions. Jeans and unsuitable footwear will not be accepted.
- Provide sleeping bags, camping mats and personal equipment for expeditions and training sessions.
- Not purchase any food/drink when on expeditions.
- Look after the environment by taking all their rubbish with them, not picking plants and not alarming any animals, whether wild, farmed or domesticated.
- Treat everyone with respect regardless of gender, ethnicity, disability, sexuality or religious beliefs.
- Act as a good role model of appropriate behaviour.
- Obey all reasonable instructions or requests from leaders or other adults in authority.
- Not get involved with any abusive peer activities (e.g. initiation ceremonies, ridiculing, bullying, cyberbullying; sexting harassment etc.).

As a committee we will:

- Provide training for the expeditions.
- Provide advice on any section of the award as requested.
- Provide group equipment for expeditions (e.g. tents, stoves maps, compasses etc.).
- Organise day trips and weekends away for training.
- Organise one practice expedition and one qualifying expedition for all groups to attend, groups who cannot make these will be expected to seek help to organise dates they can make.


