


## Code of Good Practise for: Horse-Riding Club

---

- Suitable clothing and footwear to be worn at all times. Jeans are not considered suitable clothing for riding.
- No jewellery to be worn while riding.
- Gloves and hats to standard PAS015 or BS EN1384:1997 should be worn at all times when handling horses.
- Gloves, hats and suitable boots must be worn at all times while riding. Body protectors are not compulsory but are strongly advised, particularly for jumping lessons.
- Horses should be tied-up if working with them e.g. grooming or tacking up.
- Strictly no smoking within centre boundaries.
- Access to hay loft is forbidden.
- Access to tractor and other machinery is strictly forbidden.
- Personal protective equipment is available on request e.g. riding hats to standard (WEC only), gloves, dust masks.
- Keep alleys clear and tidy.
- Report any accidents or health & safety incidents to the yard manager.
- Follow any additional instructions given to you by the yard manager – remember that they know their horses better than anyone.
- **Riding yards can be dangerous and it is important to observe these rules. Please behave sensibly – horses can act suddenly and violently when scared or frightened.**
