	Bold Routes - Some climbing routes will not offer adequate protection to be considered entirely safe. This will generally be highlighted in the guidebook or be plainly obvious from the ground. LUUMCs current soloing policy also encourages all members to apply appropriate forethought to any potentially dangerous activities. 	Hot weather	All. Dehydration, sunburn, heatstroke.	Ensure members have adequate clothing and are aware of symptoms/treatment of heatstroke, sunburn and dehydration	Continue to advise members about safety in wet weather. Check weather forecast prior to each trip.	Committee		
Travel	Road traffic accident	Passengers + Public. Collision with another vehicle and corresponding injury.	Ensure members wear seatbelts, follow LUU guidelines about minibus use.	Ensure new members understand LUU guidelines and wear seatbelts.	All		
	Collisions	Passengers. Sudden braking, whiplash.	Using a vehicle banksman where appropriate		All		
	Driver distraction	Passengers + Public.	Ensure passengers do not distract driver unnecessarily.	Ensure new members understand the risks of driver distraction.	All
