Code of Good Practice for: Leeds Snowriders

This document runs alongside the constitution. If you wish to raise issue with the contents of this code, please contact the committee named beneath in some circumstances it may be necessary to hold an EGM.

There are a few important regulations that must be observed and followed before joining Leeds Snowriders. These are to ensure the safety of its members and committee members during events and/or activities and of course to uphold the clubs reputation.

The membership fee is £20 (£16 pounds before Sunday the 26th September 2010 at 12.00pm). This needs to be paid for before reduced rates at Snowriders sessions can be used. Guests are welcome.

However to acquire the reduced rates and to be allowed on the trips a membership must be paid in full. Memberships can be taken out of holiday deposits at the end of trips.

Snowriders should always create a safe environment for other members by behaving accordingly. This is especially important for Castleford Xscape trips, during trips to Rossendale Dryslope, whether this be for racing or training, and on resort. Members are advised to wear protective, waterproof outdoor clothing, to never ski alone and to always carry a form of communication (mobile phone or radio etc.)

Consumption of alcohol at and before sessions is not advised and can lead to poor decision making in critical conditions, especially in an outdoors environment. Dryslope racing is intense and very dangerous. It is advised that protective equipment (helmets, wristguards, backprotectors etc.) are worn at all times. Members should be in good physical condition before taking part in competition.

In resort, members should wear suitable clothing at all times and never expose bare flesh, especially at night. Fancy dress is optional and keeping warm and safe at night should be the top priority. Members should always be contactable and never travel to and from events in resort alone.

Teaching sessions are external to the club. The Committee can only offer advice, unless otherwise stated. Competitions are held under supervision of the event organiser (BUDS, BUISC, etc.) and should have medical attention to hand. Some of the Committee members are first aid trained but only to be used in an emergency where no other medical attention is available.

Training sessions to Rossendale are at a price of £12, including transport and hire, and members need to pay before attending and have signed up with the club before they are allowed to attend. Castleford freestyle sessions are at a fixed rate of £20 which, again, must be paid prior to the sessions. Note that prices are subject to change throughout the year.

Transport is often external to the club but is set within session fees, if you wish to make your own way to events, you must let us know before. Social events are organised by the club but members are advised to drink responsibly and take due care at any Snowriders event. Social prices change throughout the year but a price will be disclosed prior to the event which must be payed before attending.

Should we feel a member is not upholding the conditions we have set, we may ask that person to leave the club. With no refund of their membership fee.
