

## Code of Good Practice for: WINDSURFING

- Never go windsurfing in a group of less than three people
- Always inform someone that you are going windsurfing
- Always have a method of communication, e.g phone or radio
- Always agree in advance with a member of the committee about windsurfing with club kit. Any kit taken must be signed out and in and taken good care of.
- Inform a member of the committee if there is any medical condition that may affect your ability to windsurf safely.
- Never windsurf under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Always prioritise your safety over your kit.
- Do not windsurf in conditions or on kit that is not suited to your ability.
- Always wear a buoyancy aid or windsurf harness that is correctly sized and fitted whilst on the water.
- Always look out for fellow windsurfers and follow the RYA code of good practice.
- When windsurfing at an RYA centre cooperate with the regulations of the centre.
- When windsurfing at a location cooperate with local regulations.
- Any group windsurfing must have either a qualified instructor with them or a member who has been deemed competent to supervise by the committee.
- If driving it is necessary to ensure your vehicle has been properly registered and is suitably roadworthy. This includes mini-buses, vans, rental cars, trailers and roof racks.
