Code of Good Practice for: LUU Wing Chun Soc

LUU Wing Chun Society aims to provide high quality tuition in the Chinese martial art of Wing Chun and its associated self-defence applications, traditions & culture. Classes will be run by an experienced instructor. The Society will aim to provide regular lessons (twice weekly at present) in the LUU building, and also to provide occasional social events (e.g. visits to martial arts shows, guest speakers, etc).



Any events/socials run by the Society will always take into account the key philosophy of maintaining a healthy body and mind, as this is an inseparable part of this, and indeed most, martial arts. Therefore the Society will not run events which encourage excessive drinking or inappropriate behaviour (e.g. a meal in a Chinese restaurant with alcohol available would be appropriate, whereas a 'pub crawl' would not).

The Society will always aim to provide a friendly and welcoming atmosphere for all students, regardless of age, sex, size or ethnicity. We will endeavour to help all students to progress to the best of their ability, to give them sound advice, and to encourage both them and each other to the greatest extent possible.

It is expected that students will listen to the Instructor and follow his/her commands where appropriate. Students are required to pay attention in the classes, wear suitable clothing and no jewellery (except for religious reasons) and to be punctual. Anybody who turns up drunk will not be allowed to participate.

Students should always apply themselves and try their best, and in return, the Instructor and the Committee will do their utmost to make the experience of learning Wing Chun as enjoyable and rewarding as possible.
