Code of Good Practice for:

Scottish Country Dance

We will make all members equally welcome, regardless of ability, experience or other limiting factors. We will ensure the safety of our members by upholding a comprehensive risk assessment, allowing suitable break times and including a warm up session before commencing dancing. We will provide adequate advice regarding clothing and footwear to ensure any risks to our members related to such are minimised.

We expect our members to follow instructions to the best of our abilities and to notify us of any causes for concern, being those regarding their own health or the health or endangerment of fellow members, or with any aspect of the group and its management.

We will provide adequate venues, advice, warm ups and tuition.

We will cater not only for novices, but will endeavour to ensure the progress of more talented and experienced dancers, with advanced tuition sessions and opportunities to perform.

We will endeavour to ensure all members are fully informed of any session changes, additional meetings, outside events and trips further afield. This will be to the best of our ability, via bulk e-mail, facebook groups and word of mouth. All information will be relayed in a clear, comprehensive e-mail, which members are expected to read to ensure they're fully informed.

We will ensure the classes run to a pace to suit all our members, and will allow late-arrivals and mid-term fledgling members, by allowing persons to join in whenever they have either picked up a dance already being danced or at the start of the next dance of the session.

We will accept any Leeds University student as a member at any time, be it during any session of the term, or by e-mail or facebook contact.

We endeavour to be accessible to our members when they need us. Our e-mails will be checked regularly, and outgoing mail will include the names and phone numbers of our committee members.

We will adhere to the LUU social guidelines.
