Code of Good Conduct for: Snooker & Pool

This is a non-exhaustive list of rules and can be removed, modified or added to at any time by the Committee. This document is in addition to LUU's rules regarding club guidelines and behaviour and the Club's Code of Good Practice and Health and Safety information.

Membership of the Club can be obtained through online payment to LUU, the successful outcome of which enables your name and student number to be viewed by members of the committee. You will be contactable by the Committee through email, unless you opt out, but your email address will not be viewable.

Tournaments

Only members as recognised by LUU will be eligible to compete in Universities Pool Council (UPC) or British Universities and Colleges Sport (BUCS) events.

Upon verbal agreement to take part in these or similar events you will be liable to the costs of complete participation in the event e.g. transport, event registration and accommodation, minus any subsidy provided by the Club. If after agreement participation is not possible the original costs will still need to be met by the individual and any additional costs paid, including fines imposed by the event organisers. If a suitable replacement member (on a like-for-like basis regarding complete participation) can be found the original costs will not apply. If participation is not possible due to exceptional circumstances e.g. hospitalisation or close family bereavement, each case will be treated on an individual basis and all members will make good same.

All participants will receive the same level of subsidy provided the measures in place to enable complete participation are used e.g. individuals without a railcard will incur extra costs if rail transport is used. If any member wishes not to use these measures e.g. arrange own transportation or accommodation, the level of subsidy will be reduced. Once measures have been arranged by the Club, individuals will have to meet the costs if they subsequently choose not to make use of the measures in place e.g. if after agreeing to complete participation, accommodation and/or transport is not used, the associated costs will be met by the individual.

Any fines and subsequent costs incurred to the Club by the actions of an individual or individuals will be paid for by those in question and not the Club e.g. non-attendance at meetings or damage to accommodation. Objections, at an individual level, to fines will be able to be made directly to the event organisers or relevant parties.

At Any Time

Any damage or costs incurred to the venue that the Club is in attendance at will be rectified or paid by the individual or individuals whereby the results were as a consequence of their actions.

Basically, everything will be fine if you're a reasonable person and keep to your commitments.
