Code of Good Practice for: Snooker & Pool

1 Introduction

1.1 Leeds University Union Snooker & Pool Club (the club) will operate so far as reasonably possible, in accordance with the following document, its risk assessment and current LUU Sports Office & governing body guidelines.

1.2 The club plays in tournaments organised by national governing bodies the Universities Pool Council and BUCS.

1.3 It is the responsibility of the President and the Treasurer to ensure that membership fees are paid in advance of sessions and tournaments.

1.4 The club will appoint a new committee during the Summer term.

2 Club Activities

Risk Assessment documentation must be made available to members, but participants should be aware that they are responsible for their own actions, especially if they choose to disregard advice given by the committee or organiser

3 Accident and Emergency Procedures

The club will follow the LUU Sports Office Sport and Physical Activity Accident and Emergency Procedures.

4 Complaint Procedure

4.1 The club will address complaints from members on any issue regarding the club's activities, including, but not limited to, safety of activities, standards of instruction or leadership, standards of equipment, poor club administration, lack of suitable activities for their level of participation.

4.2 Complaints should be directed first to the President, who will discuss the matter with the committee. Complaints may, when reasonable, be escalated to the club's development coordinator at LUU.
